Conclusion of the illegal fishing and human trafficking cases in the fisheries sector (since 2015 to 28 Feb 2018)

Total of Litigation against offenders, 4,285 cases

3,679 cases has been closed (86%) with the offenders sentenced

1. Thai Overseas FVs

- since 2015 (Start of Enforcement Royal Ordinance on Fisheries 2016)
- 54 of the 80 cases has been closed (67%) with the offenders sentenced

2. Thai & Foreign FVs in Thai waters

- since 2015 (Start of CCCIF)
- 857 of the 1,083 cases has been closed (79%) with the offenders sentenced

3. Failed to installation of VMS

- since April 2016
- 2,005 of the 2,023 cases has been closed (99%) with the offenders sentenced

4. Uninformed Harbor in specific time

- since April Oct 2016
- 163 of the 171 cases has been closed (95%) with the offenders sentenced

5. Pre-processing Aquarius Animal

- **since Nov 2015**
- 49 of the 74 cases has been closed (66%) with the offenders sentenced

6. Human trafficking cases in the fisheries sector

- since Jan 2015
- 32 of the 86 cases has been closed (37%) with the offenders sentenced

- 519 of the 757 cases has been closed (68%) with the offenders sentenced
